

**NIDA Studios** are for committed and creative individuals seeking an intensive and practical training experience.

Designed to develop skills and techniques in the performing arts, NIDA Studios deliver rigorous, practice-driven training in a supportive and collaborative environment. Classes are delivered on weekends over 6 or 12 months with a twice-yearly intake.

Students complete a NIDA Studio having gained an understanding of their personal creative process and a skill set that prepares them for full-time training. NIDA Studios are a first step towards exploring a career in the performing arts, or simply an opportunity to enhance your personal and professional creative life.

Entry to a studio course is by audition or interview only and class sizes are kept to a minimum, ensuring a high-quality and focused course delivery as well as a professional working environment.

# SYDNEY MELBOURNE BRISBANE

## SATURDAYS 11AM-5PM JANUARY INTAKE

## **15-18 YEARS**

Develop your vocal, physical and imaginative dexterity as you explore and apply NIDA acting techniques. Collaborate with other young artists in an ensemble to develop skills for stage and screen. Work with the support and direction from core tutors and gain inspiration from industry professionals.

#### TERM 1 7 FEB – 28 MAR

Develop skills in improvisation, action-based acting technique and stagecraft. Extend vocal range and flexibility. Collaborate as an ensemble to rehearse and produce a collaborative presentation employing a variety of texts including poetry and spoken word.

#### TERM 2 2 MAY – 20 JUNE

Explore and employ movement techniques to develop physical presence and build stamina for performance. Consider the physical aspect of characterisation; prepare and present classical and contemporary text work.

#### TERM 3 25 JUL – 12 SEP

Learn and apply audition techniques and processes through the preparation and presentation of monologues.
Collaborate as a member of an ensemble to devise an original contemporary work. Understand how to employ various production elements to enhance your work. Perform your original work to an invited audience.

#### TERM 4 17 OCT – 5 DEC

Apply acting techniques to scene work for camera – rehearse and shoot challenging scenes. Hone your skills for the industry as you participate in simulated screen tests and casting sessions.

#### **OUTCOMES**

- Use improvisation as a tool for devising scenes and creating characters
- Apply appropriate vocal and physical techniques in performance
- Respond to a variety of classical and contemporary texts
- Effectively collaborate with others
- Apply acting skills to the screen context
- Prepare audition materials with confidence.

# SYDNEY MELBOURNE



## 18+ YEARS

Develop individual and collaborative performance skills. Craft a structured, personalised approach to your work as a performer through practical actor training focused on skills development and application.

This course provides the opportunity to explore and apply contemporary acting techniques to a variety of contexts, and develop your vocal, physical and imaginative dexterity. Work with support and direction from experienced tutors and gain insight and inspiration from professional industry guests.

This course is ideal for those wishing to explore their potential as an artist or those preparing for higher education.



**Instrument Work:** extend your vocal range and find physical freedom through fundamental voice and movement training for the actor.

Imagination and Collaboration: work as an ensemble to develop spontaneity in performance through improvisation and impulse work.

Apply vocal, physical and acting technique to develop character and inform work with text.

#### TERM 2 3 MAY – 21 JUN

Classical Technique: extend your performance range by working with iconic classical texts, re-imagined for the 21st century. Engage with the demands of heightened language, bold physicality and challenging stagecraft.

#### **Contemporary Scene Work:**

develop performance approaches and techniques to realise a range of challenging contemporary material. Apply rehearsal practices and techniques to produce performances that are truthful and engaging.

#### TERM 3 26 JUL – 13 SEP

Contemporary Acting and Audition Technique: refine your personal acting process and respond intuitively in a variety of performance contexts. Select appropriate audition material. Identify and apply effective audition techniques for a range of industry demands.

#### TERM 4 18 OCT – 13 DEC\*

**Studio Project:** collaborate with a director to rehearse a full-length play. Sustain truthful responses while meeting the staging demands of performance. Present the work in a studio setting to an invited audience.

\*Please note this is a 9-week term

#### **OUTCOMES**

- Employ improvisation as a tool for creating character
- Respond to and perform a variety of classical and contemporary scripts
- Realise a director's vision and writer's intent in performance
- Work as part of an ensemble, applying appropriate etiquette under performance conditions
- Develop authentic characterisation
- Prepare and rehearse audition material
- Apply acting skills to screen performance.

## 18+ YEARS

Working closely with industry professionals, this course explores advanced audition and screen acting techniques to further enhance your individual strengths in performance. Expand your technical skill set by adopting the roles of key personnel in the creative team to gain greater understanding of the collaborative nature of bringing work to the screen.

Actors Studio Extension is ideal if you have completed our Actors Studio or Screen Actors Studio, or if you have equivalent industry training or experience.

#### TERM 1 8 FEB – 29 MAR

#### **Contemporary Performance**

**Craft:** receive comprehensive coaching to extend your practice and skill set. Apply a variety of contemporary acting techniques to challenging theatrical texts.

## **TERM 2** 3 MAY – 21 JUN

#### **Advanced Camera Technique:**

receive in-depth coaching and work autonomously on your onscreen performance. Identify how to consolidate your strengths and expand your potential in both studio and on-location performances. Shoot multiple scenes with two contrasting narratives.

#### TERM 3 26 JUL – 13 SEP

#### **Screen Tests and Industry Practice:**

enhance your performance technique, learn to deliver impressive screen auditions, and gain insight into self-promotion.

Voice Over Technique: develop a synthesised approach to interpreting text and employ vocal technique to bring unique characters to life in a recording studio. Record material under the guidance of a voice over industry professional.

#### TERM 4 18 OCT – 13 DEC\*

Mike Leigh Project: inspired by the working processes of award-winning filmmaker Mike Leigh, collaborate with a professional director to develop your own devised screen project. Plot and craft your character arc and sustain that journey in performance. Receive a copy of your material.

\*Please note this is a 9-week term

#### **OUTCOMES**

- Deepen your individual performance practice and personal skill set
- Embrace technical factors in performance across a variety of screen contexts
- Develop production content with a creative team
- Apply in-depth practice of screen tests to current industry standards
- Identify professional opportunities and understand how to position yourself according to industry needs.

#### **PREREQUISITES**

Previous experience necessary. We recommend applicants complete **Actors Studio** or equivalent training before applying to this course. Entry to the Actors Studio Extension is by application and selective audition only.

### 18+ YEARS

Craft a structured, personalised approach to your work as a screen performer. Gain experience in casting and insights into industry practice through practical actor training focused on skills development and application.

This one-year Studio provides the opportunity to explore and apply acting techniques and develop your vocal, physical and imaginative dexterity for screen. Work with support and direction from experienced tutors as you develop self-assurance in relating to the camera.

This course is ideal for those wishing to explore their potential as a screen artist.



#### TERM 1 8 FEB – 29 MAR SYDNEY & MELBOURNE

**BRISBANE** 

Instrument Work: develop vocal and physical presence specifically for the screen. Extend vocal range and freedom and explore how physical action informs character objectives.

Imagination and Relationship to Camera: develop spontaneity in performance through impulse work. Apply vocal, physical and acting technique to improvised and scripted scenes performed to camera.

Performance for Visual Storytelling:

explore and apply appropriate acting techniques for screen under the direction of an industry professional.

**Presence:** realise a character arc and employ a variety of acting techniques to develop a truthful and engaging performance. Explore ways to connect with audiences through the lens. Rehearse and shoot contemporary scene work.

**Applied Instrument Work:** learn and apply an American accent to text. Utilise physical impulses to create spontaneous performance on screen.

**Style and Genre:** develop your performance technique and explore the contrasting genres of drama and comedy. Shoot scene work in onsite locations.

## 18+ YEARS

This course is designed as a two-term program that focuses on developing a secure approach to acting through song. Gain confidence in your approach to storytelling and enhance your performance technique with consistent, practical application.

Collaborate with a director and musical director in rehearsing solos, duets, and ensemble repertoire.

# TERM 1 JAN INTAKE | 7 FEB – 28 MAR JUL INTAKE | 25 JUL – 12 SEP

Instrument Work: develop your vocal range and physical presence with classes tailored towards acting though song. Explore how physical action and the use of appropriate vocal technique informs character objectives.

#### **Storytelling and Performance:**

create engaging characters and learn how to communicate a visual narrative as you apply technique in solo performance contexts, including auditions. Learn effective approaches to transition from scene to song and synthesise your skills within an ensemble.

# TERM 2 JAN INTAKE | 2 MAY – 27 JUN\* JUL INTAKE | 17 OCT – 12 DEC\*

**Genre and Style:** explore a variety of singing and dance techniques to interpret contemporary and classical repertoire.

#### **Rehearsal and Performance:**

create dynamic and truthful performances through the application of singing and acting techniques. Meet the demands of challenging staging in a theatrical context and present a selection of material to an invited audience.

- Develop truthful characterisation
- Respond to a variety of musical theatre genres
- Perform material in a variety of performance contexts
- Deliver audition material with confidence
- Identify professional opportunities and how to position yourself according to industry needs.

## SATURDAYS 11AM-5PM JANUARY & JULY INTAKE

## 18+ YEARS

This course is designed as a two-term program that develops skills for both Live Performance (Term 1) and Screen/ Digital Media (Term 2). Examine techniques best used in contemporary story-making. Receive guidance and direction in a supportive studio environment and collaborate with actors to test your ideas for stage and screen.

## TERM 1 JAN INTAKE | 7 FEB - 28 MAR JUL INTAKE | 25 JUL - 12 SEP

**Stage:** explore the principles of effective storytelling for a range of live performance contexts. Activate stories by developing action and dialogue. Hone your craft through redrafting, editing and collaborative peer review.

# TERM 2 MAR JAN INTAKE | 2 MAY – 27 JUN\* SEP JUL INTAKE | 17 OCT – 12 DEC\*

Screen: examine small and large screen formats. Investigate style and genre, understand how to transform your ideas to create an effective plot, premise, protagonist and dramatic problem. Build your story into a narrative structure specific for your chosen format.

\*Please note this is a 9-week term

#### **OUTCOMES**

- Create a strong synopsis
- Consider a range of possible structures and genres
- Develop a dynamic narrative
- Develop engaging scenes for a range of characters
- Work in small and large screen formats
- Use cinematic and visual storytelling methods
- Identify professional opportunities and how to position yourself according to industry needs.

## SATURDAYS 11AM-5PM JANUARY & JULY INTAKE

## 18+ YEARS

This course is designed as a two-term program that develops skills for both Live Performance (Term 1) and Screen/ Digital Media (Term 2).

Consider the director's role and examine the specific directorial demands for stage and screen. Explore the principles of effective storytelling for both media and collaborate with actors to pursue your creative vision and create dynamic performances. Learn how to lead a creative team, motivate a cast and inspire audiences.

# TERM 1 JAN INTAKE | 7 FEB - 28 MAR JUL INTAKE | 25 JUL - 12 SEP

**Stage:** gain insight into the actor's process and explore ways to realise text and concepts in performance for the stage. Critically analyse the work of other directors and develop an understanding of the language and technical challenges of live performance.

# TERM 2 JAN INTAKE | 2 MAY – 27 JUN\* JUL INTAKE | 17 OCT – 12 DEC\*

Screen: explore the visual, dramatic and technical challenges that directors face when applying their skill to storytelling for the screen. Consider script requirements, shot composition, visual detailing, lighting and sound techniques, continuity and the actor's journey.

\*Please note this is a 9-week term

#### **OUTCOMES**

- Form collaborative working relationships with actors
- Interpret a stage or screen play
- Develop creative concepts
- Apply a structured rehearsal process for stage and screen
- Practise different rehearsal techniques
- · Create storyboards and frame shots
- Explore creative possibilities in stage and screen direction.
